Re: RECOMMENDATIONS FROM
INCARCERATED VETERANS

When Our Country Called On Us, We Answered! Many of us answered in the time of War and we Proudly Defended Our Country! Due to a multitude of reasons, we now find ourselves, Incarcerated Veterans. Many of us still suffer from PTSD, others are here cause they fell to the Drug Epidemic, some of us became Religious Conservative Advocates and find ourselves Prisoners of the War of past Administrations against Christians and yet others are here due to some of our bad choices and decisions. Regardless, we are all Veterans and we are all incarcerated. In 2014, your Commission adopted Amendment 782, which became known as the 2-Level Drug Reduction for inmates that got caught up in the Nation's Drug War, but yet us Vets that actually went to War to Protect & Defend Our Country have never seen any Thank You Relief Measures from your Commission. This somehow in the eyes of many, just does'nt add up! In view of this, we are making the following recommendations: 1.) All incarcerated Vets, that are First Time Offenders and Non-Violent, need to be placed on Home Confinement, Retroactively, 2.) All incarcerated Vets that Served In A time of War and are Non-Violent, not Terrorist, or Child Molesters need to receive a 3-Level Reduction in their Sentence and 3.) All Disabled Combat Vets receiving Disability Checks should have their checks continued, payable to their families, while incarcerated and should receive a -COMPASSIONATE RELEASE+++++for Having Suffered in Defense of their Country.
