I would like to express the fact that I was disappointed when the Commission did not consider making the Career Offender Guidelines Retroactive to reduce sentences for offenders incarcerated for priors that no longer qualify for Career Offender enhancements. My father

was sentenced as a Career Offender 2015 to "151 month's" based on the "Residual Clause", only to have the Sentencing Commission Amend and change those Guidelines in November of 2015. That Career Offender sentence increased his sentence by 6 additional years from 77-96 months to 151 to 188 months respectively.

I am asking that you take up the issue of making the Career Offender Guidelines Retroactive, Please.
