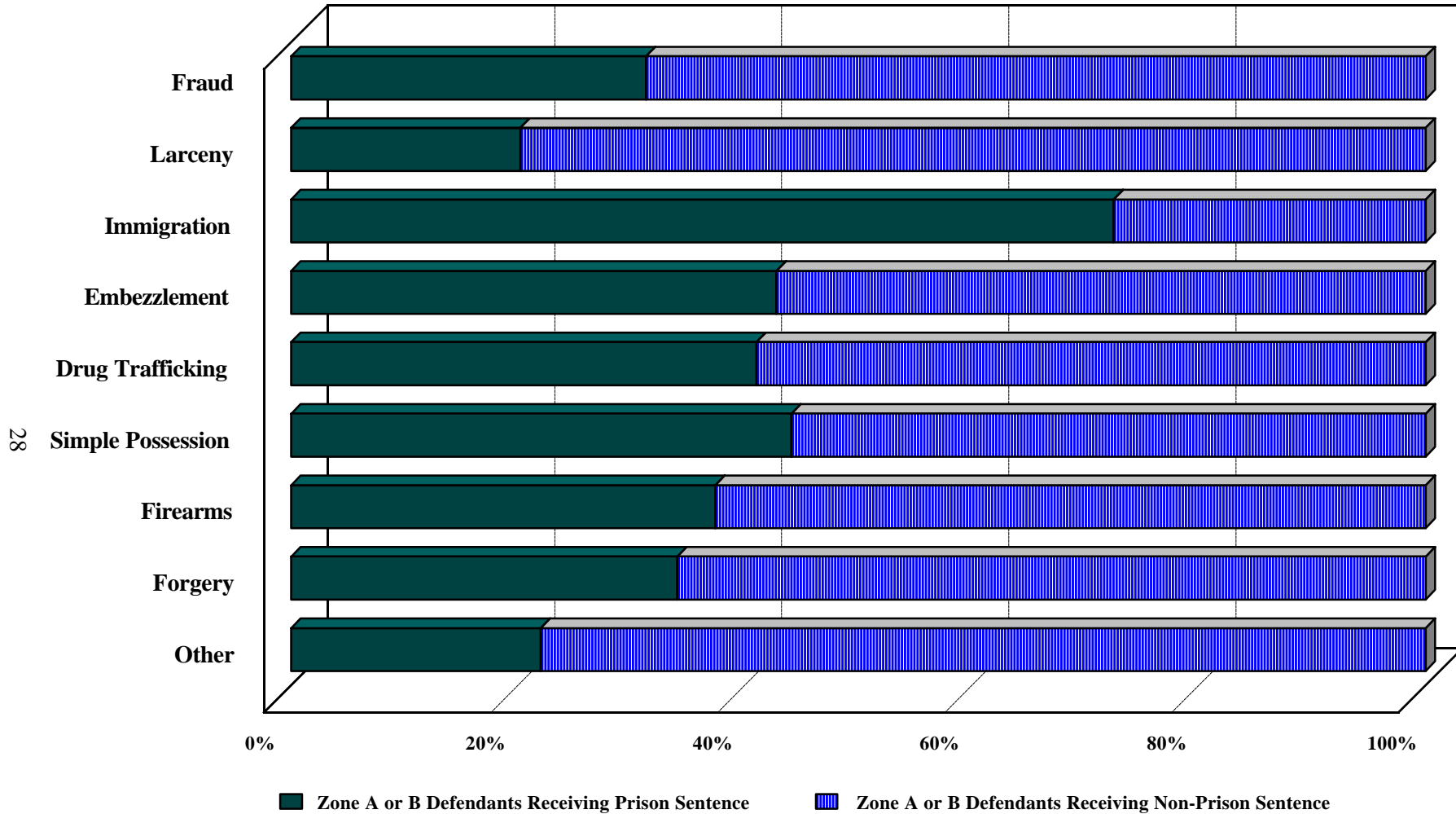

<sup>1</sup>Of the 42,436 cases, the Commission received complete guideline application information for 37,125. Of these 37,125 cases, 7,917 were eligible for non-prison sentences because their guideline sentence ranges were in Zones A or B. In addition, one case was excluded due to missing information on offense type. Prison sentences include either prison alone or prison with conditions of alternative confinement as defined in USSG 5C1.1. Non-prison sentences include either probation alone or probation with conditions of confinement. Descriptions of variables used in this figure are provided in Appendix A.
