

Of these 46,252 cases, 6,949 were eligible for non-prison sentences because their guideline sentence ranges were in zones A or B. Prison sentences include either prison alone or prison with conditions of alternative confinement as defined in USSG §5C1.1. Non-prison sentences include either probation alone or probation with conditions of confinement. Descriptions of variables used in this figure are provided in Appendix A.
