


## IMPRISONMENT RATES OF OFFENDERS ELIGIBLE FOR NON-PRISON SENTENCES IN SELECTED OFFENSE TYPES<sup>1</sup> Fiscal Year 2009



<sup>1</sup>Of the 81,372 cases, the Commission received complete guideline application information for 71,054 cases. Of these 71,054 cases, 12,200 were eligible for non-prison sentences because their guideline sentence ranges were in Zones A or B. Prison sentences include either prison alone or prison with conditions of alternative confinement as described in USSG §5C1.1. Non-prison sentences include either probation alone or probation with conditions of confinement. Descriptions of variables used in this figure are provided in Appendix A.
