Of these 23,782 cases, 21,579 involved powder cocaine, crack cocaine, heroin, marijuana, or methamphetamine. Of these 21,579 cases, 8,584 had a base offense level of 12, 26, 32, or 38. Of these 8,584 cases, 3,264 were excluded due to one or more of the following reasons: involvement of more than one drug type (1,462), missing drug amount or range (1,929), or logical criteria (38). Of the remaining, 99 cases were excluded from the crack cocaine category because the offenses were sentenced prior the enactment of the 2010 manual, which changed the weight requirements for each base offense level. Descriptions of variables used in this table are provided Appendix A.
