Of the 80,035 cases, 21,952 were sentenced under Drug Trafficking (§2D1.1). Of these, 21,481 cases had complete guideline application information. Of these 21,481 cases, 19,057 involved powder cocaine, crack cocaine, heroin, marijuana, or methamphetamine. Of these 19,057 cases, 8,205 had a base offense level of 12, 26, 32, or 38. Of these 8,205 cases, 3,266 were excluded due to one or more of the following reasons: involvement of more than one drug type (1,475), missing drug amount or range (1,890), or logical criteria (12). Of the remaining, two cases were excluded from the crack cocaine category because the offenses were sentenced prior the enactment of the 2010 manual, which changed the weight requirements for each base offense level. Descriptions of variables used in this table are provided in Appendix A.
