¹ Of the 75,836 cases, 21,152 were sentenced under Drug Trafficking (\$2D1.1). Of these, 20,534 cases had complete guideline application information. Of these 20,534 cases, 18,222 involved powder cocaine, crack cocaine, heroin, marijuana, or methamphetamine. Of these 18,222 cases, 7,813 had a base offense level of 12, 26, 32, or 38. Of these 7,813 cases, 3,364 were excluded due to one or more of the following reasons: involvement of more than one drug type (1,346), missing drug amount or range (2,076), or logical criteria (87). Of the remaining, nine cases were excluded from the crack cocaine category because the offenses were sentenced prior the enactment of the 2010 manual, which changed the weight requirements for each base offense level. Descriptions of variables used in this table are provided in Appendix A.
