Of the 71,003 cases, 20,790 were sentenced under USSG Chapter Two, Part D (Drugs), regardless of eligibility for the Safety Valve (§5C1.2). Of these, 20,602 cases were sentenced under §§2D1.1 (Drug Trafficking), 2D1.2 (Protected Locations), 2D1.5 (Continuing Criminal Enterprise), 2D1.6 (Use of a Communication Facility), 2D1.8 (Rent/Manage Drug Establishment), or 2D2.1 (Simple Possession). Of these, 19,959 cases contained complete guideline application information. Of these 19,959 cases, 189 were excluded due to missing safety valve or mandatory minimum information. Descriptions of variables used in this table are provided in Appendix A.
