Of the 66,873 cases, 11,457 were sentenced below the guideline range with *Booker/*18 U.S.C. § 3553. Of these, 11,226 cases had complete guideline application information. Due to an inability to calculate the extent of departure for cases with a guideline minimum of life, an additional 65 cases were also excluded from this table. Of the remaining 11,161 cases, four were excluded due to missing sentence information. Note that the information presented in this table does include sentences of probation, but does not include any time of alternative confinement as described in USSG §5C1.1. Descriptions of variables used in this table are provided in Appendix A.
