# VARIABLE CODEBOOK FOR FEDERAL ESCAPE OFFENSES DATAFILE



# Introduction

This codebook is for the U.S. Sentencing Commission's analysis datafiles used for the report Federal Escape Offenses. The report included analyses of individuals sentenced for escape between fiscal years 2017 and 2021. The report can be found on the U.S. Sentencing Commission's website at: Federal Escape Offenses | United States Sentencing Commission (ussc.gov)

There is one analysis datafile for this report which combines data for fiscal years 2017 through 2021. All variables listed in the codebook are available in the 2017-2021 datafile.

The datafile contains subsets of the Commission's fiscal year Individual Datafiles, the Criminal History of Sentenced Individuals datafile, and additional escape case information collected on 1,487 individuals sentenced for an escape offense between fiscal years 2017-2021. Of the 1,487 individuals, 1,458 escaped and 29 aided or abetted the escape of another person. This report focuses on the 1,458 who escaped, excluding the 29 that aided or abetted. Commission staff undertook a special coding project to gain information about the relative risk associated with persons who escape from facilities. This information included determining the nature of the escape and the person's behavior while on escape status.

Variables from the Individual Datafiles are identified as "USSCFY Datafiles" in the ORIGIN column in the codebook. Variables from the Commission's criminal history datafile are identified as "USSCCH Datafiles" in the ORIGIN column of the codebook. Additional information for variables from these datafiles can be found in their respective codebooks: *Variable Codebook for Individual Datafile: Standardized Research Data Documentation for Fiscal Years 1999-2021* and *Variable Codebook for Criminal History Datafile*. Both codebooks are available at ussc.gov. Several variables in the datafiles are either recoded variables from the Commission's datafiles or are variables created from data collected in the special coding project and are identified as "Esc Pub" in the ORIGIN column of the codebook.
