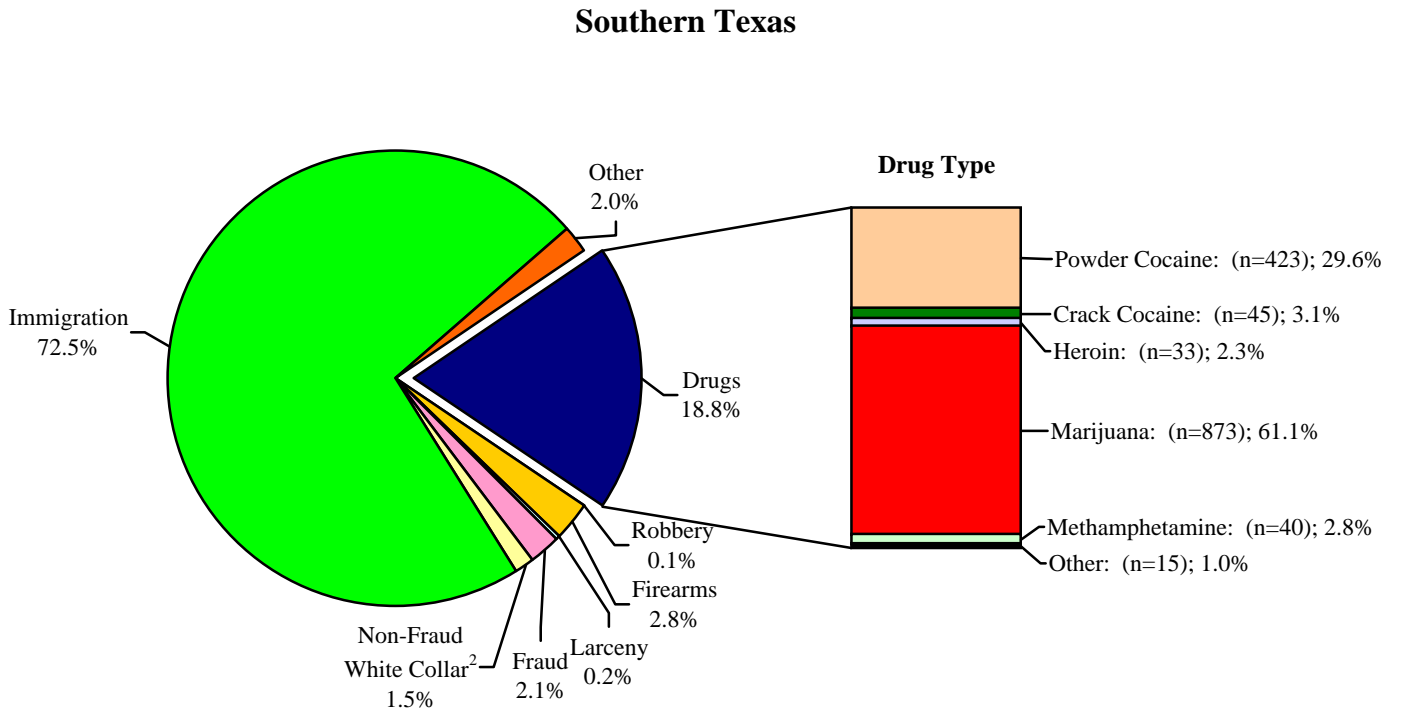
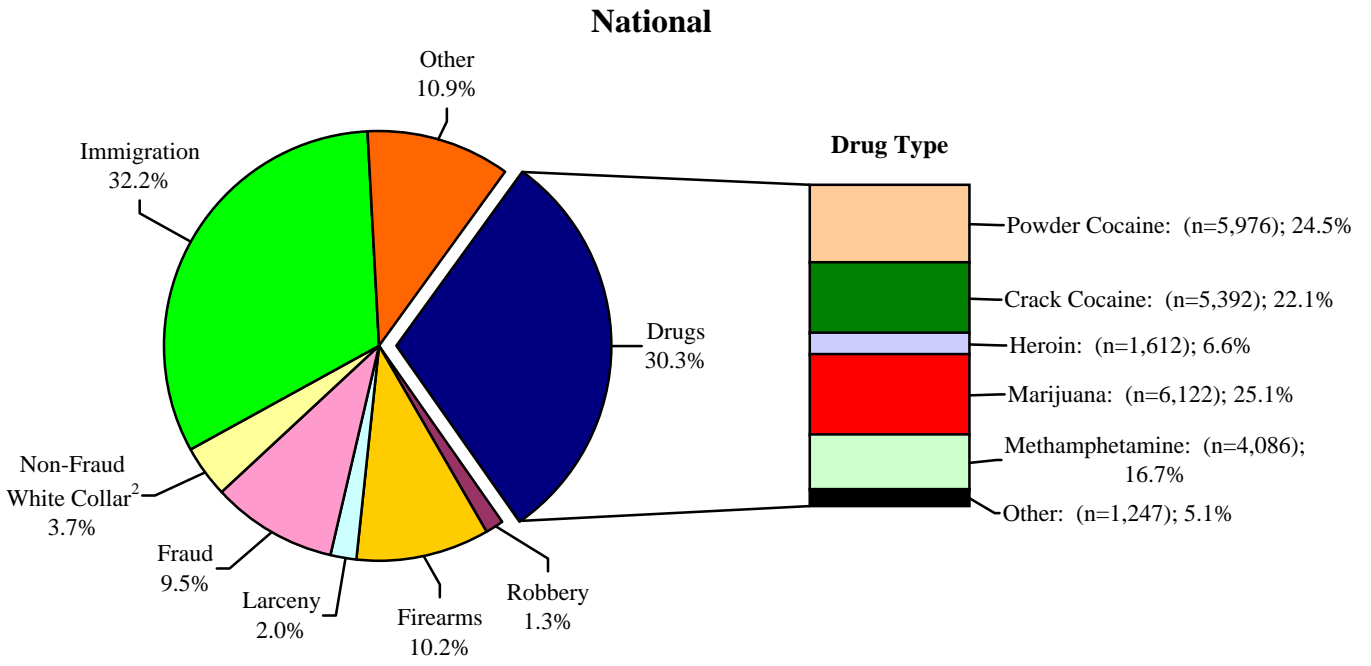

Of the 81,372 cases, 2,219 were excluded because information was missing from the submitted documents that prevented the comparison of the sentence and the guideline range. Districts for which information needed to determine the relationship between the sentence imposed and the guideline range is missing in five percent or more of the cases received included: Middle Georgia (27.0%), Arizona (20.3%), Eastern Virginia (13.2%), Maryland (10.9%), Southern Mississippi (8.7%), Northern New York (8.4%), Southern Florida (5.3%), and Middle Tennessee (5.0%).
