Several years ago, the Sentencing Commission was contemplating the idea of eliminating the two-level enhancement for use, of a computer in child pornography offenses, noting that with increased use of computers and the internet, nearly all child pornography cases now qualify for the enhancement. So I was surprised to see that in your proposed amendment to § 2G2.2, there was no mention of striking this enhancement. This SOC is superfluous and striking it would assist in lowering the variance rates on child pornography offenses, which I believe is still the highest of any guideline.
