I would like to make a suggestion to the USSC. I'm a supervisory probation officer and currently work in a border division. Every day we see the influx of violations of TSR on 8 USC §1326 cases. I would like to recommend that the USSC consider doing away with TSR on these defendants and instead add another SOC to include enhancements for defendants who return within three years. Statistics show that TSR is not a deterrence on these defendants. The amount of paperwork and costs involved are extreme and place a heavy burden on not only taxpayers, but also place a heavy burden on the federal agencies involved.

Perhaps this is something that can be taken into 2019 guidelines amendments.
