Minutes of the August 1, 1989 United States Sentencing Commission Business Meeting

Chairman Wilkins introduced Ken Roberts, a new law clerk working for Commissioner Corrothers.

David Anderson summarized his memorandum concerning the denial of Federal benefits pursuant to \$5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988 (21 U.S.C. §853a). The Commission considered action appropriate to address the issues raised in this memorandum.

-- Motion made by Commissioner Corrothers to promulgate an emergency guideline which will serve as notice to the courts of the statutory provisions codified in 21 U.S.C. §853a; seconded by Commissioner Nagel. Passed unanimously.

Commissioner Nagel stated that David Anderson's memorandum concerning this issue and John Steer's input were extremely helpful.

Commissioner Nagel requested that the Commission schedule a presentation to be given at the earliest appropriate time by the Office of National Drug Control Policy.

Nolan Clark and Peter Hoffman discussed the revised corporate sanction draft. Commissioner Nagel requested that the Commission circulate to designated persons the corporate sanction test document proposal for comment prior to the implementation of the actual field test. Various drafting changes were suggested to the corporate sanction working group for incorporation into the proposal, including a request to draft special rules for fines.

Chairman Wilkins announced that the next Commission meeting would be held on August 12, 1989, at 9:30 A.M.
