Of these, 26,047 were sentenced under §§2D1.1 (Drug Trafficking), 2D1.2 (Protected Locations), 2D1.5 (Continuing Criminal Enterprise), 2D1.6 (Communication Facility), 2D1.8 (Rent/Manage Drug Establishment), or 2D2.1 (Simple Possession). Of these, 23,769 contained complete guideline application information. Of these 23,769 cases, 15 were excluded due to one or both of the following reasons: missing drug type (15) or missing acceptance of responsibility information (0).
