Of these, 6,037 were sentenced under §§2D1.1 (Drug Trafficking), 2D1.2 (Protected Locations), 2D1.5 (Continuing Criminal Enterprise), 2D1.6 (Communication Facility), 2D1.8 (Rent/Manage Drug Establishment), or 2D2.1 (Simple Possession). Of these, 5,632 contained complete guideline application information. Of these 5,632 cases, four were excluded due to one or both of the following reasons: missing criminal history information (1) or missing drug type (3).
