¹Of the 18,203 cases, 6,105 were sentenced under USSG Chapter Two, Part D (Drugs). Of these, 6,037 were sentenced under §§2D1.1 (Drug Trafficking), 2D1.2 (Protected Locations), 2D1.5 (Continuing Criminal Enterprise), 2D1.6 (Communication Facility), 2D1.8 (Rent/Manage Drug Establishment), or 2D2.1 (Simple Possession). Of these, 5,632 contained complete guideline application information. Of these 5,632 cases, three were excluded due to one or both of the following reasons: missing weapon information (0) or missing drug type (3). Descriptions of variables used in this table are provided in Appendix A.
