¹Of the 51,865 cases, 18,427 were sentenced under USSG Chapter Two, Part D (Drugs). Of these, 18,195 were sentenced under §§2D1.1 (Drug Trafficking), 2D1.2 (Protected Locations), 2D1.5 (Continuing Criminal Enterprise), 2D1.6 (Communication Facility), 2D1.8 (Rent/Manage Drug Establishment), or 2D2.1 (Simple Possession). Of these, 16,632 contained complete guideline application information. Of these 16,632 cases, seven were excluded due to one or both of the following reasons: missing role information (0) or missing drug type (7).
