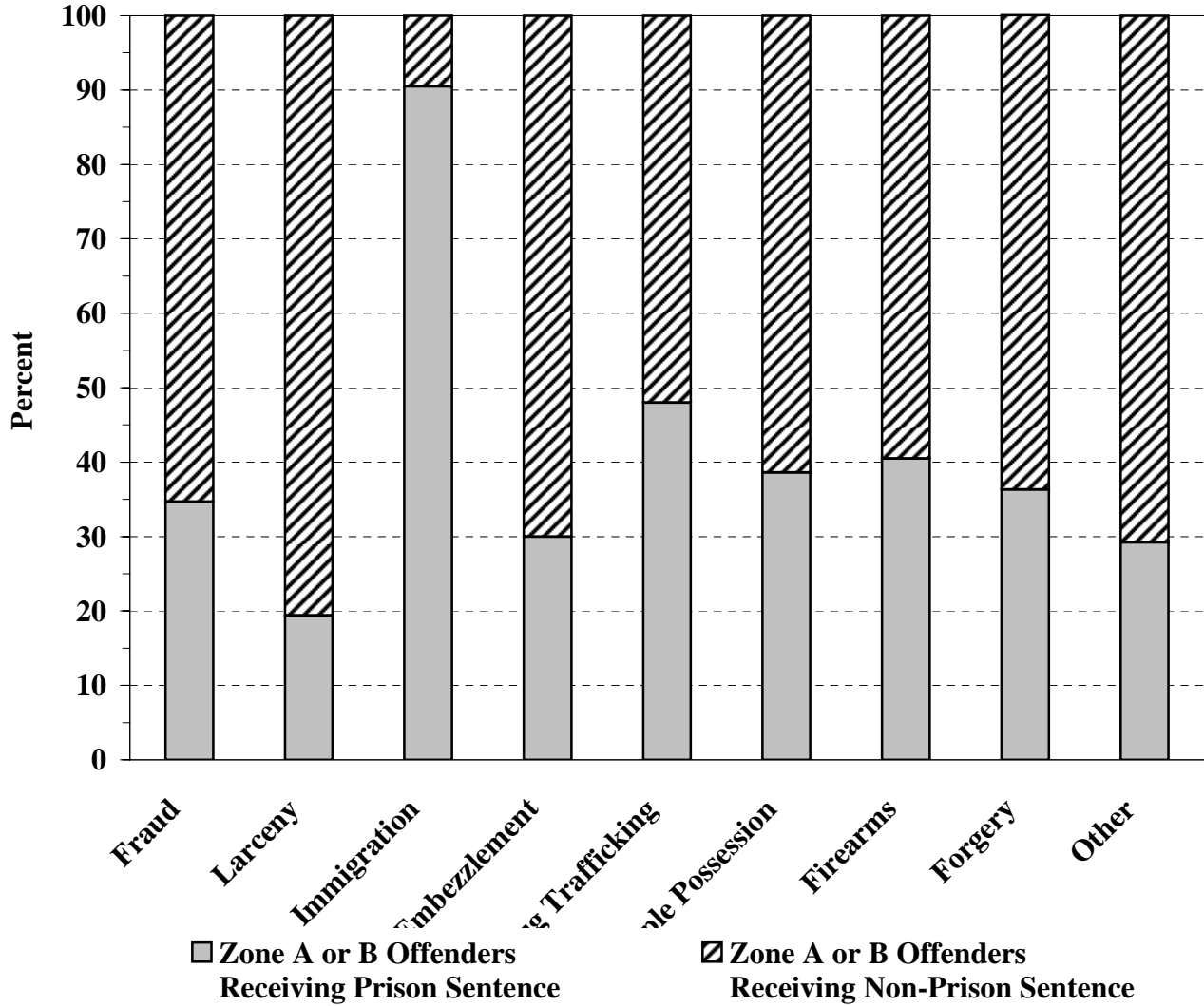

<sup>1</sup>Of the 18,788 cases, the Commission received complete guideline application information for 15,212 cases. Of these 15,212 cases, 2,579 were eligible for non-prison sentences because their guideline sentence ranges were in zones A or B. Prison sentences include either prison alone or prison with conditions of alternative confinement as defined in USSG §5C1.1. Non-prison sentences include either probation alone or probation with conditions of confinement. Descriptions of variables used in this figure are provided in Appendix A.
