¹Of the 53,674 cases, 18,743 were sentenced under USSG Chapter Two, Part D (Drugs). Of these, 18,519 were sentenced under §§2D1.1 (Drug Trafficking), 2D1.2 (Protected Locations), 2D1.5 (Continuing Criminal Enterprise), 2D1.6 (Communication Facility), 2D1.8 (Rent/Manage Drug Establishment), or 2D2.1 (Simple Possession). Of these, 17,454 contained complete guideline application information. Of these 17,454 cases, six were excluded due to one or both of the following reasons: missing drug type (6) or missing acceptance of responsibility information (0).
