Of these, 25,824 were sentenced under §§2D1.1 (Drug Trafficking), 2D1.2 (Protected Locations), 2D1.5 (Continuing Criminal Enterprise), 2D1.6 (Communication Facility), 2D1.8 (Rent/Manage Drug Establishment), or 2D2.1 (Simple Possession). Of these, 24,410 contained complete guideline application information. Of these 24,410 cases, 10 were excluded due to one or both of the following reasons: missing role information (0) or missing drug type (10).
