Of these, 25,491 were sentenced under §§2D1.1 (Drug Trafficking), 2D1.2 (Protected Locations), 2D1.5 (Continuing Criminal Enterprise), 2D1.6 (Communication Facility), 2D1.8 (Rent/Manage Drug Establishment), or 2D2.1 (Simple Possession). Of these, 24,243 contained complete guideline application information. Of these 24,243 cases, two were excluded due to missing information on drug type. Descriptions of variables used in this table are provided in Appendix A.
