¹Of the 76,478 cases, 24,605 were sentenced under Drug Trafficking (§2D1.1). Of these, 23,637 had complete guideline application information. Of these 23,637 cases, 22,232 involved powder cocaine, crack cocaine, heroin, marijuana, or methamphetamine. Of these 22,232 cases, 8,486 had a base offense level of 12, 26, 32, or 38. Of these 8,486 cases, 3,347 were excluded due to one or more of the following reasons: involvement of more than one drug type (1,534), missing drug amount or range (1,968), or logical criteria (79). Descriptions of variables used in this table are provided in Appendix A.
