¹ Of the 83,946 cases, 23,479 were sentenced under Drug Trafficking (§2D1.1). Of these, 22,791 cases had complete guideline application information. Of these 22,791 cases, 20,718 involved powder cocaine, crack cocaine, heroin, marijuana, or methamphetamine. Of these 20,718 cases, 8,018 had a base offense level of 12, 26, 32, or 38. Of these 8,018 cases, 2,871 were excluded due to one or more of the following reasons: involvement of more than one drug type (1,313), missing drug amount or range (1,696), or logical criteria (45). Descriptions of variables used in this table are provided in Appendix A.
