¹ Of the 86,201 cases, 25,664 were sentenced under USSG Chapter Two, Part D (Drugs). Of these, 25,278 cases were sentenced under §§2D1.1 (Drug Trafficking), 2D1.2 (Protected Locations), 2D1.5 (Continuing Criminal Enterprise), 2D1.6 (Use of a Communication Facility), 2D1.8 (Rent/Manage Drug Establishment), or 2D2.1 (Simple Possession). Of these, 24,772 contained complete guideline application information. Of these 24,772 cases, three were excluded due to missing information on drug type. Descriptions of variables used in this table are provided in Appendix A.
