¹ Of the 80,035 cases, 4,092 received an other government sponsored downward departure. Of these, 3,901 cases had complete guideline application information. Due to an inability to calculate the extent of departure for cases with a guideline minimum of life, an additional 33 cases were also excluded from this table. Of the remaining 3,868 cases, four were excluded due to missing sentence information. Note that the information presented in this table does include sentences of probation, but does not include any time of alternative confinement as described in USSG §5C1.1. Descriptions of variables used in this table are provided in Appendix A.
