<sup>1</sup> Of the 75,836 cases, 6,068 received an other government sponsored downward departure. Of these, 5,845 cases had complete guideline application information. Due to an inability to calculate the extent of departure for cases with a guideline minimum of life, an additional 34 cases were also excluded from this table. Of the remaining 5,811 cases, three were excluded due to missing sentence information. Note that the information presented in this table does include sentences of probation, but does not include any time of alternative confinement as described in USSG §5C1.1. Descriptions of variables used in this table are provided in Appendix A.
