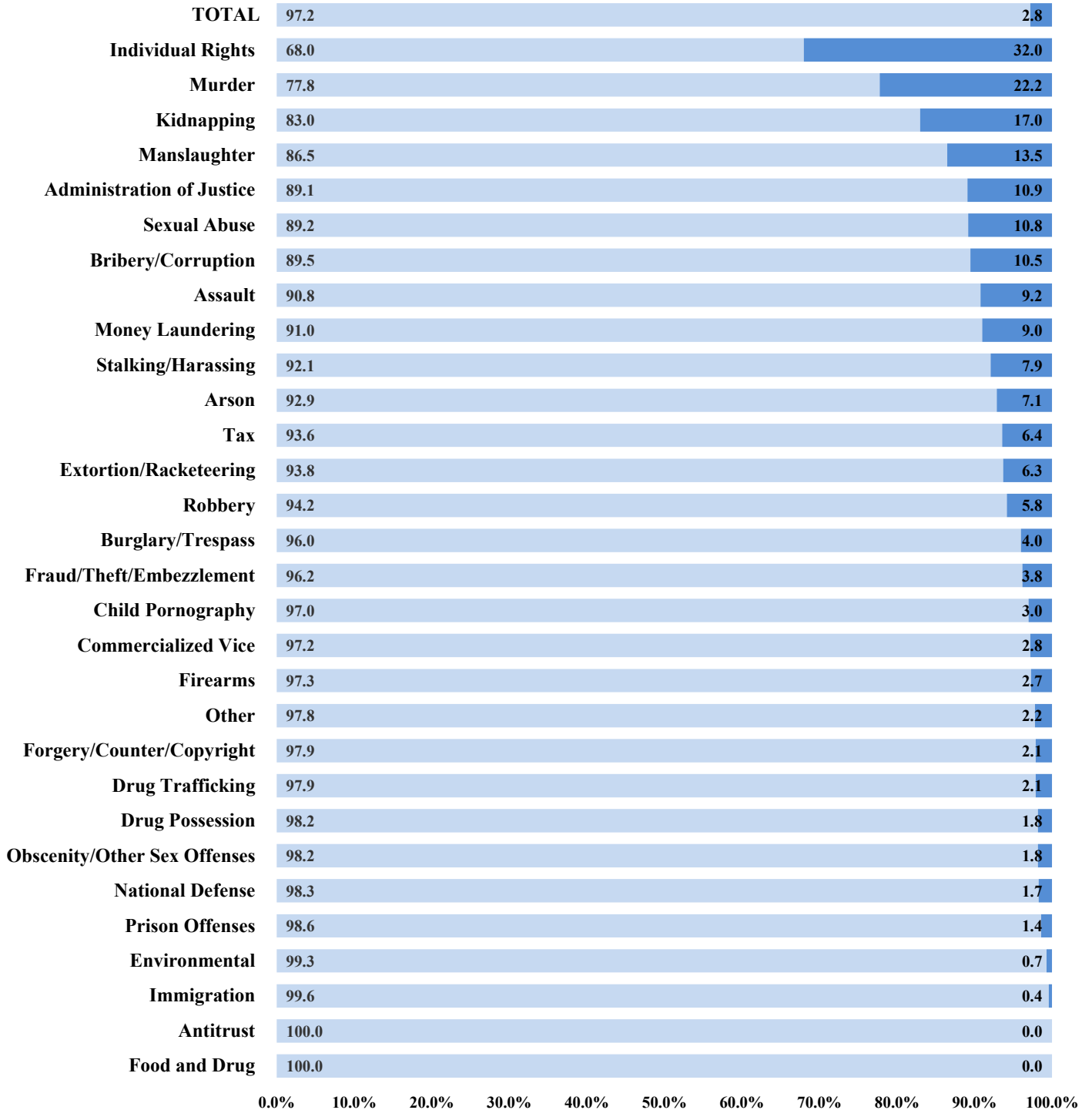

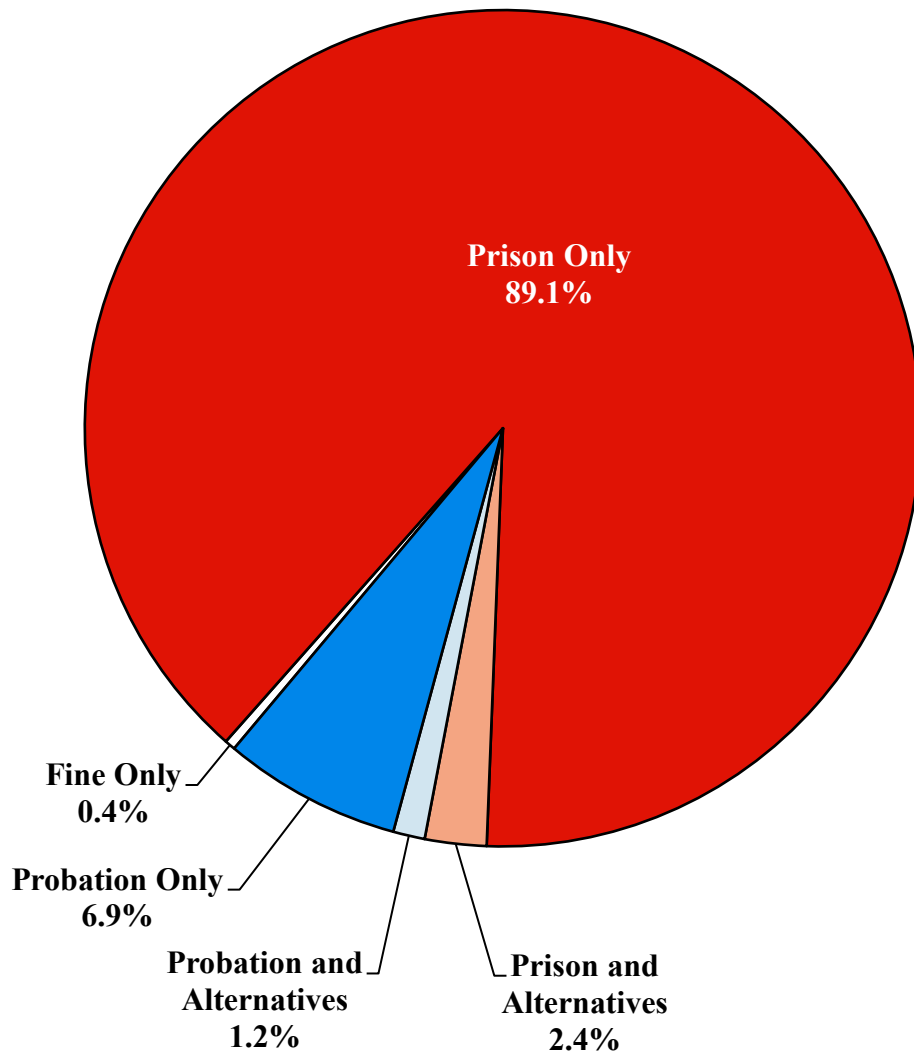
GUILTY PLEAS AND TRIALS BY TYPE OF CRIME¹
