Of these, 6,669 individuals were sentenced under §§2B1.1 (Theft, Property Destruction, and Fraud Offenses), 2B1.4 (Insider Trading), 2B1.5 (Cultural Heritage Resources), 2B2.1 (Burglary), 2B3.1 (Robbery), 2B3.2 (Extortion), 2B4.1 (Bribery), 2B5.1 (Counterfeiting), or 2B5.3 (Copyright). Of these 6,669 cases, 30 were excluded due to missing information on the individual's education. Descriptions of variables used in this table are provided in Appendix A.
