The remaining appeals cases involved the following: type of appeal was 'conviction only' (1,431), 'unknown' (512), the appeal was by the government only (12), the appeal was of an issue related to a post sentencing matter (947), and/or the appeal was of a sentence imposed upon the revocation of probation or supervised release (444). Descriptions of variables used in this table are provided in Appendix A.

² Of the 1,997 cases affirmed, 29 (1.5%) cases were remanded to the district court.

³ Of the 228 cases reversed, 228 (100.0%) cases were remanded to the district court.

⁴ Of the 41 cases affirmed in part and reversed in part, 41 (100.0%) cases were remanded to the district court.
