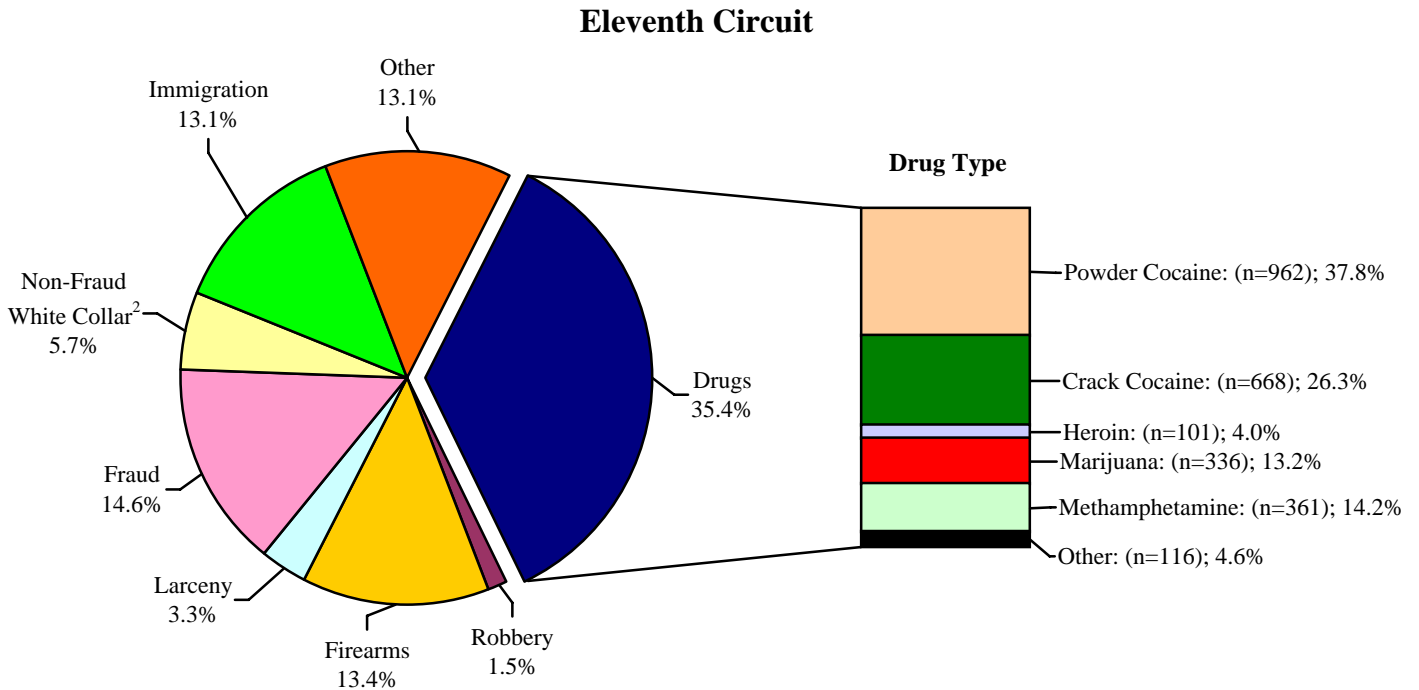
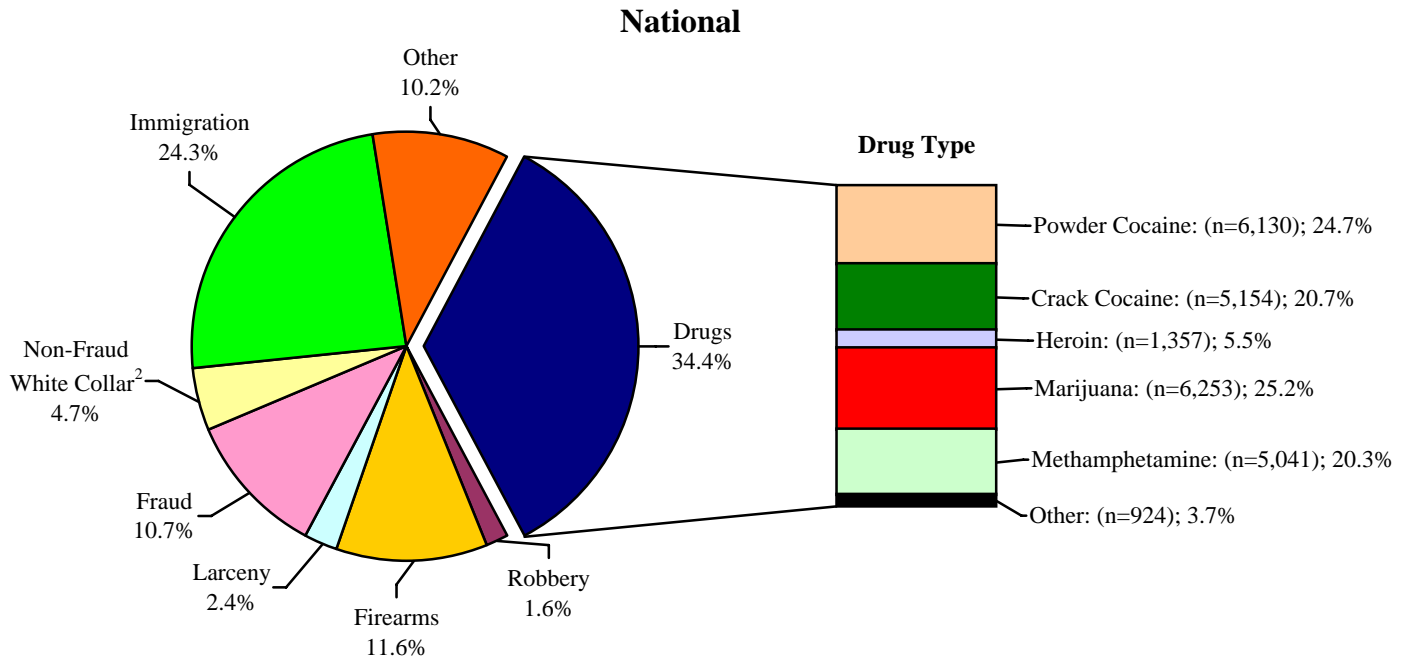

Of the 72,865 guideline cases, 9,892 cases were excluded for one or more of the following reasons: zero months prison ordered (9,091), missing primary offense category (100) or missing or indeterminable sentencing information (801).

Of the 7,243 guideline cases from the Eleventh Circuit, 1,276 cases were excluded due to one of the following reasons: zero prison months ordered (1,190) or missing or indeterminable sentencing information (86).

Of the 72,865 cases, 2,972 were excluded because information was missing from the submitted documents that prevented the comparison of the sentence and the guideline range. Districts for which information needed to determine the relationship between the sentence imposed and the guideline range is missing in five percent or more of the cases received included: Western Oklahoma (42.2%), Middle Georgia (27.1%), Central California (25.5%), Eastern Virginia (24.1%), Arizona (17.1%), Western Washington (11.3%), Middle Tennessee (10.1%), Southern Mississippi (7.0%), Maryland (6.6%), Western Kentucky (6.3%), Alaska (6.1%), Northern Alabama (5.5%), Southern Florida (5.2%), and Northern Florida (5.0%).
