




District of Native American Offenders Fiscal Years 2012 and 2013




Race of United States Citizen Offenders Fiscal Year 2012




Age of United States Citizen Offenders by Race Fiscal Year 2012

United States Citizen Offenders in Criminal History Category I By Race Fiscal Year 2012




Primary Guideline Applied In Native American Offenses Fiscal Year 2012






Average Sentence for United States Citizen Offenders by Race Fiscal Year 2012












Native American Coding Project Past Convictions Fiscal Year 2012

Native American Coding Project Alcohol/Drug Use While Committing Instant Offense Fiscal Year 2012




Native American Coding Project Average Sentence for Violent and Non-Violent Offenders Fiscal Year 2012
